- Conceptual models and tables
 - When integrating expert feedback and a piece of the conceptual model isn't mentioned by experts, you have the following options:
 - 1. Delete it because the experts didn't say anything about the threat
 - 2. Minimize it because the experts didn't mention it
 - 3. Draft a question that we will send back to the experts
 - In general, save the old drafts, but parse down things to make them more simplified
 - In the "details" section of Miradi, you can add in the expert feedback
